President Todd Bong called to order this regular meeting of the Tremont Village Board at 7:00 PM, Monday, February 15, 2010, at the Tremont Village Hall.

**MINUTES**

Trustee Replogle moved to approve the minutes for the regular February 1 meeting, and Zuercher seconded.

**BILLS**

Trustee Zuercher moved to approve all bills incurred since the February 1 meeting, and Replogle seconded.  
AYES: All            NAYS: None    Motion carried.

Trustee Scott moved to approve the following sewer rate increase effective in May 2010: Sewer rate increases from \$9.00/month to \$16/month. For users over 10,000 gallons the rate will increase to \$20/month. In May of 2011, the increases will be \$18/month and \$22/month. In May of 2012, the increases will be \$20 and \$24/month. Replogle seconded.

Citizens are urged to visit the Village of Tremont website to further understand the reasoning for such an increase and the benefits, as well as the rationale and prices charged by surrounding communities.

Trustee Zuercher conveyed thanks to police officer Jim Brown for his help with a tour of the facilities by the Tiger Scouts last Saturday.

Trustee Replogle informed the Board that the County will order more than 4000 traffic signs to be used by various Tazewell municipalities including Tremont which will receive over 200 new signs by August of this year. Replogle and Streets Superintendent Brian Hild are in the process of creating a new plan for sign changes within the village limits.

Trustee Harding moved to transfer \$7065.91 from General Savings to Police Operations to cover bills and payroll. Zuercher seconded.

Also, Harding moved to transfer \$1078.80 from Motor Fuel Tax Fund to General Savings for partial payroll. Scott seconded.  
AYES: All            NAYS: None    Motion carried.

Attorney Dick Wherry will have new police ordinance drafts ready for review at the March 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Board.

Scott Getz, representing *The New Beginnings Church* was present to offer up manpower for some tear down and

reframing at the old liquor store. He will meet with Mike Pfloderer to review Mike's working drawings.

Trustee Replogle will find model resolutions for the Board to use in writing up a new resolution for IDOT to supply a turn lane at the high school.

President Bong directed Attorney Wherry to research possible need for an ordinance in creating a Handicap Loading Zone across from the Fire Station. Brian Hild will be consulted to provide the proper location and dimensions.

Police Chief Mike Dodwell reported that he had a two-hour informal informational meeting with the *Tremont Women's Club*.
