**MINUTES**

Trustee Replogle moved to approve the minutes for the regular November 2 meeting, and Conover seconded.

Trustee Zuercher moved to approve the November 2 Executive Session minutes, and Conover seconded.

Trustee Zuercher moved to approve all bills incurred since the November 2 meeting, and Scott seconded.

Trustee Harding seated at 7:08 PM.

Trustee Stuber informed the Board that the work on Franklin Street has been completed, and that the storm sewers on the West side of town have been televised, and we will be receiving video tapes shortly. Stuber will also contact Street Superintendent Brian Hild about getting the storm sewers on Route 9 cleared out. Trustee Stuber reported that the Community Center was left a mess Friday and that lights were left on in the building.

Trustee Zuercher reported that an H1N1 vaccine clinic will be held Thursday, November 19 at the high school and that two local police officers will be on sight and paid for by Tazewell County.

Trustee Replogle informed the Board that the Chestnut Street property which had been a problem has been cleaned up and vehicles have been moved. Zoning Code Officer Earl Ropp will do a final check on the property

Trustee Harding moved to transfer \$7673.44 from General Savings to Police Operations to cover bills and payroll. Conover seconded.

Also, Trustee Harding moved to transfer \$1853.35 from Motor Fuel Tax Fund to General Savings for a partial payroll. Zuercher seconded.

Finally, Trustee Harding reminded the Board that the Levy Ordinance will be presented for adoption at the December 7 meeting.

Trustee Stuber expressed concern over employee wages reported in *The Pekin Times*.

President Bong directed the Board to devise plans or ways to efficiently move from the current Community Center to the small building next to the former *Super Valu*.

Attorney Richard Wherry reminded the Board that the new **Freedom of Information Act** is scheduled to become law on January 1, and that the Board should become more familiar with various information which will become public record. President Bong will appoint an assistant FOI rep in case Trustee Conover should be unavailable.

In final business, President Bong urged the Board to make a decision by next meeting concerning video gaming in Tremont.
