Trustee Scott informed the Board that Tremont residents can expect sewer rates to rise in the near future. This rise is due to necessity with water tower and sewer plant improvements looming, not just because Tremont's rates are so much lower than surrounding municipalities.

Trustee Zuercher reported that an employee overtime study has been completed and is available to interested trustees.

Trustee Conover has completed a FOIA rough draft and will meet with Attorney Richard Wherry to finalize the package. Conover has also contacted AmerenCilco and informed them that a key is available at the Village Hall so that they can read the meter which is located inside the former Supervalu building

Trustee Harding moved to transfer \$7,541.59 from General Savings to Police Operations to cover bills and payroll. Zuercher seconded.
