Variance Hearing

The Village of Tremont Zoning Board will conduct a Variance Hearing at 7:00PM, Thursday, October 24, 2019 at the Village Hall.

The purpose of this hearing is whether to grant:

A variance to Section 1203(4), to allow more than one accessory structure in an R-1 Zoning District.

A variance to allow the construction of an accessory structure to be 1200 square foot which is 800 square foot larger than allowed in an R-1 Zoning District

A variance to Section IV of Chapter 404.1 (b), to allow the construction of an accessory structure to have vertical metal siding in an R-1 Zoning District.

What did you do last Sunday?

In 1890, the village ordinances outlined strict guidelines:

"It shall not be lawful for any person or persons in (Tremont) on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, to engage in the amusement or exercise of dancing or fiddling, singing songs, jumping, drilling, skating, running foot races, running horses, playing at ball, ten pins, billiards, cards, marbles, or other games, wrestling, boxing, pitching quoits, fishing, hunting, or in any amusement of the like nature, and every person convicted of any of the offenses last enumerated, shall forfeit and pay the same penalty as in section one hereof provided." (Pay not less than one dollar or more than one hundred dollars.)
