Tremont Athletic Booster Club

Everyone loves the bright lights of Tremont athletics, but behind the scenes is the Booster Club acting as the backbone of Tremont's sports programs.

The Booster Club helps finance the teams and raise money for the uniforms, gear, and supplies. The club helps teams that do not generate enough profit such as in concession sales. Club members taking time out of their lives to help is vital in the continuation of all Tremont's sports.

Vice President Lisa Scott understands the effects of the Booster Club on the community. "We build a sense of "Turk pride" amongst the community and make that visible to those visiting our community from opposing teams."

The Booster Club is also felt to be important to the community. "I personally feel it's very important. It's the best way to spotlight our hard-working student athletes, and also bring financial assistance to the District to offset the cost of operating sports programs."

Changing over the years, the club has really grown exponentially over the last 16 months.

"The Booster Club that exists today was just started in May of 2018 by a group of about a dozen parents whose goal was to make things better for Tremont athletes," Scott said.

With last year being the first year launching the new program, there were most likely doubts about whether it would be successful or not. However, the work of the Booster Club paid off, and they helped the athletics program at Tremont significantly.

"Its first year of operation was very successful... [it] contributed about \$20,000 back to the school for athletic team needs," Scott said.

The impact that the Booster Club has on the sports teams have been clear to the players as well.

"I know that the Booster Club really helps our teams out with money, and we don't have to worry about it as much anymore. We are also getting new jerseys for both baseball and basketball, and we are all excited and thankful for what the booster club does," Senior Ryan Wagenbach said.

Another goal of the club is to get the community more involved and to shine a spotlight on student athletes. A recently added event known as "Meet the Turks" helps to achieve that goal. The event allows young children who look up to the athletes an opportunity to meet the stars.

"We also hope to appeal to younger students in District 702 to be interested in Turks athletics and create a desire in them to want to put on the Maroon & White and become a Turk in the future," Scott said.

The future of Tremont athletics is undoubtedly bright, and with the new and improved Booster Club, it can only get better from here.
