#### Did you know...?

In early 1840, just five years after Tremont was founded, two stage coach lines were established between Peoria and Bloomington, and between Peoria and Springfield. Mail, passengers and express packages were carried daily by four-horse teams. Several years later, one of the passengers was the young lawyer, Abraham Lincoln. When the weather was nice, he would sit up on the seat with the driver the entire way from Peoria and Springfield, entertaining with stories and jokes, for which he was famous.
