Did you know...?

The year was 1834. About 50 people arrived here in wagons, bringing only the barest necessities. Immediately they laid out the town, building a schoolhouse, and a church, and establishing a post office. They introduced many improvements, which made the town at that early date "...a center of intelligence, enterprise, and good society, scarcely equalled by many larger places in the west. They chose, as the name of their enterprise, "Tremont." - (quote from an early newspaper article.)
