Did you know...?

According to the 1844 Tazewell County Whig newspaper, farmers of the Tremont area in 1944 could relate to the farmers in 2019.

June 21, 1844

"The late rains have destroyed a vast deal of property. Our townsman, Dr. Saltonstall, is a sufferer to the amount of about \$2,000 and our friend, Charles Bergen, has lost a valuable crop and much fencing. The crops on the Mackinaw bottom have been much injured or entirely destroyed. The Mackinaw River was, on Saturday last, nearly two miles wide, of course impassable."
