Early Rural Mail Carriers

At one time, there were three rural Tremont mail carriers, Charlie Alexander (pictured), Billy Morrisey, and Guy Kinsey.

Madeline Kinsey, born 1904, was the daughter of Guy Kinsey. When sharing memories in 1991, she recalled, "I remember, in the winter time, my mother would heat the bricks on the stove, wrap them in newspaper, and put them on the floor of that little box wagon dad took on his route - 25 miles... it took him all day with that little old wagon and horse! And, oh my, the roads back then! Mud - PLAIN MUD!"
