Did you know ...?

In 1836, Tremont won the coveted county seat, moved from a temporary court location once an impressive courthouse was built in 1839, and soon became a center of business for the Illinois Judicial 8th Circuit. Abraham Lincoln was a young lawyer, and David Davis was the judge. Along with another lawyer, they traveled by horseback and carriage from town to town on the circuit to hear cases, coming to Tremont often. The two became good friends. Many locations in Tremont lay claim to hosting Lincoln overnight, and likely Judge Davis as well.

Skip forward a few decades. Judge Davis was instrumental in getting Lincoln nominated, then elected as President of the United States. Lincoln nominated Judge Davis to the U.S. Supreme Court.

Not only had Tremont been visited often by a future U.S. President, but a future U.S. Supreme Court Justice as well. And there's more to the story...
