Early newspapers are a treasure to read, especially articles pertaining to Tremont. Fortunately, the Tremont Museum has several, both digitized and in the fragile, original form. Additionally, we have archived articles from the Pantagraph of Bloomington, Illinois. The news of the day was generally local, daily happenings. Below are some items of interest that were considered newsworthy.

The Pantagraph, May 14, 1884 (News from Tremont)

- Wm. Buchele of Tremont is happy over the arrival of a bouncing boy at his home.

- A much-needed addition to the side track at Tremont is being made by the I.B.&W. railway company.

- Jap Morgan has a smile as wide as a crushed pumpkin and is happy as a boy at his first circus. She is a girl and weighs nine and three-fourths pounds, clothed in smiles and chirrups.

The Pantagraph, March 8, 1889 (News from Tremont)

- A.G. Norman's new store will be completed soon

- Robert Goodyear is loading his household effects and will move to Cropsey, Ill.

- At the meeting of the town board on Monday evening, G.H. Case was appointed city marshal, with orders to light the street lamps.

- John Hurley, our present postmaster, expects to learn telegraphy at Danvers, when his term expires here.

The Pantagraph, December 17, 1889 (News from Tremont)

- Miss Eva McDonald spent Sunday at Mr. John Russell's.
- The Congregational church will have a Christmas tree on Christmas Eve.


