
The Cliftwood

If you are over a certain age, you might recall Miller's Cliftwood Inn restaurant in Morton, Illinois. It had a supper club-type atmosphere and was known for great steaks and chopped lettuce salads served in chilled pewter bowls.

The original Cliftwood Inn was opened in 1931 by the Rapp family. It was named after one of their popular lines of pottery. In the beginning, the restaurant also served as a place to display their pottery. The wives of the Rapps worked at the Inn, with the men helping when time allowed. Two-and-one-half years later, the Inn sold, and through the years, as other owners took over, the name "Cliftwood" remained.

Today, the building has been thoroughly remodeled and exists as Lin's Buffet.

Tremont Comprehensive Plan

The Comprehensive Plan for Tremont is available for review on the Village's website. A public hearing will be held on **Monday, November 7 at 6:00PM at the Community Center.** The purpose of the public hearing is to gather additional information, comments,

and suggestions prior to the Village Board's vote on the Plan. The community is invited and encouraged to participate.

A comprehensive plan is a critical component as the inevitable changes over time occur in every community. Evaluating current strengths and weaknesses can assist leaders and community groups as they grapple with their collective visions for the future.

Not only does the comprehensive plan act as a guide for how the community should grow; it is also a legal document that will give Tremont a say in new development decisions. The plan doesn't just serve as a guide for the community at its current municipal boundary; it also expands that boundary out for 1.5 miles. This means that any development that occurs within these 1.5 miles must also meet the goals of the comprehensive plan.

Water Main Flushing

Annual Water Flushing to take place the Week of October 17 - 21.

Water Main flushing allows any sediment and stagnant water to be removed from the distribution system and also provides an opportunity to test the operability of the hydrant.

During flushing, water may become temporarily discolored and customers should avoid washing clothes until the water has cleared. These steps are taken to improve the overall water quality within the distribution system and to ensure the delivery of the highest quality water possible.
