#### The Night the Stars Fell

Noted speaker Bill Kemp, Librarian of the McClean County History Museum in Bloomington, Illinois.

On Nov. 13, 1833, a meteor shower known as "the night the stars fell" became an almost religious event. The nighttime heavens lit up like a Fourth of July sparkler as tens of thousands of meteors streaked through the darkened sky. It proved to be the greatest meteor shower in U.S. history. What did the scattered early residents make of this fantastic and fearful display? At this time, Central Illinois was a frontier, and meteor showers were a mysterious and misunderstood phenomenon.

Bill promises a lavishly illustrated program sure to fascinate even those folks with little interest in - or knowledge of - astronomy.
