Tremont's Early Obituaries, Part II

Obituaries through the years have evolved into those we see today. The word obit means death. Deaths have been reported in many different ways, with trends developing from time to time.

There was a period where the activities of the deceased on the day they died were reported in detail:

"While he had been in poor health the past year, he kept at his work at the Keystone Wire Plant in Bartonville. He had been at work the night before his death, but complained of feeling ill when he left his work in the morning. When he arrived home in the bus that morning, he had to be carried into his home and he expired a few hours later."

"(She) departed this life last Sunday morning after a week of terrible blood poisoning. While attending her son who was suffering from an abscess, she received a scratch with a pin with which she was inoculated with the virus which caused her death."

Illnesses we rarely if ever hear of today were common: consumption, pneumonia, Bright's Disease, apoplexy, Typhoid Fever, Scarlet Fever, uremia, rheumatism of the stomach, and the flu (or influenza), which is what they called the Spanish Flu; these are just some of the ailments people in Tremont once suffered.

Tragic accidental deaths were described in dramatic and sometimes gruesome detail. The vividly descriptive language would never be used in an obituary today. Train, farm, and automobile accidents were plentiful. And there were murders here, as well as suicides and mysterious circumstances.

Eloquent phrases were used to express grief and faith, such as:

Her spirit took flight

(They) have sunk into sleep eternal,

...removes pain and earthly sorrow and ushers the trusting soul into the happy realms of the great beyond...

Our community, like every other small town, felt the loss of each soul, and grieved with the families left behind, just as we do today. It is something that connects us to those who once lived here.

A group of people from the Tremont Historical Society gathered obituaries from the earliest settlers up until 1988. They produced two volumes of these records of life and death. If you are interested in purchasing them, they are \$5.00 each, cash or check. They are on sale at the museum on second and fourth Sundays from 1:00-4:00PM, or by calling 309-840-0094.
