The Fate of Leslie Farms

Continuing from Last Week: Archie Robison Jr. never married. For years, he lived at the Victorian style "White House," together with his parents and his accomplished sister Mary, a professor emeritus of English at Bradley University. Mary also never married. After their parents died, the two siblings lived out their lives in the mansion at Leslie Farms.

In 1970, at the age of 83, Archie Robison, Jr., died of a heart attack. He was remembered as an important importer and breeder of purebred Percheron horses, as well as a revered horse judge. He was instrumental in building on to the long legacy of Leslie Farms, located at the corner of Springfield Road and today's State Route 9.

The property was willed to the state of Illinois after Archie's death. The portion of land with the grand white mansion was a separate parcel, set aside for his sister, Mary. And Mary continued to live in the 19-room family home until her death in 1986. Tragically, a devastating fire in January of 1987 destroyed the beautiful home. The one occupant who was home at the time escaped safely.

The 30 acres of land that had been willed to the state was not large enough to be a state park, so the property was offered to the Forest Park Foundation. The foundation planted 11 acres of trees there. In 1988, an attorney from the foundation coordinated a service project with Tremont Cadette Girl Scout Troop 193 to plant deciduous trees on the property.

A 1988 article in the Pekin Times stated, "Half of the original acreage was virgin prairie - it had never been plowed. No fertilizers or herbicides had touched it. The other half of the acreage had been plowed only four times since World War II, but again no chemicals had ever been used. It is one of the few remaining sites of true Prairie land that the Native Americans and early European settlers would have known."

At some point in the years following Mary's death, a small portion of the land began to be farmed by a Tremont farmer. A thick stand of trees now stands between Route 9 and the property, shielding it from view there. The simple road sign, "Leslie Farm Road," is all that indicates a major horse farm once operated there. The railroad tracks were torn up when the trains stopped running, and the busy Leslie Station is no longer there.

But recently, new life has been breathed into the area. In 2018, The Forest Park Foundation contacted the Tremont Lions Club to see if they would become stewards of the property. They agreed, and today the private property is a retreat for the Scout troops of Tremont.



Registration is open from 8/1 through 8/26 for 4th, 5th and 6th grade girls. Register at the Fitness Center Office during our open hours or online at tremontpark.org

FEE: \$100.00 - Fee is due at time of registration or the first week of practice. This fee goes towards the cost of patched officials, insurance, tournament fees and gym usage fees.

TEAMS - Teams may be combined. We may have two or three teams depending on numbers. We currently have two coach volunteers and will be looking for additional help. The coaches will be announced once the teams are divided.

GOAL - The goal of this program is to provide girls an opportunity to learn and practice the fundamentals of basketball in a structured setting and to experience basketball at a competitive level against other teams their age. Our goal is to prepare the players for junior high and high school sports. Keeping kids active and participating in team activities is essential. Youth sports develop confidence and character and allow kids to have fun. Keeping our youth together will prepare them to play together in junior high and high school.

INFORMATION - Home games are played at Tremont High School. Practices are scheduled twice a week at Tremont Grade School Gym.
