The Start of a Tradition

Ernie Getz was the first commercial turkey farmer in Central Illinois. He was followed by others, including Willard and Les Schweigert, Dan Sinn, and Donald Connell, who started his business in 1960, raising 40,000 turkeys a year at its height. Ernie, however, is remembered as the first large-scale commercial farmer. He started out raising several hundred turkeys each year for holiday markets in the 1930s. After 35 years of turkey raising, he was processing 7,000 turkeys annually.





In 1935, Ernie Getz purchased basketball uniforms for the Tremont High School boys' basketball team, leading the team nickname, "The Tremont Turks". The Turks remain the school mascot today.

Due to the number of large turkey farms in the area, and the school's nickname, the first town festival was call the Tremont Turkey Festival. It's name remains a tribute to this important part of Tremont's history!


