Did You Know ...?

Contractor J.L. Benson

World War II had ended. The fortunate servicemen were able to come back to their hometown of Tremont. But life did not immediately go back to prewar normalcy. Supplies were still hard to come by, with many shortages. In the midst of this, Tremont contractor J.L. Benson had a plan. He felt it was the least he could do to build some housing for

veterans. Because of the shortages, people only laughed at his idea.



But, *The Pekin Daily Times* of June 19, 1946, noted, "Wheedling and coaxing for materials, Benson set to work on a plan to build at least seven homes for sale exclusively for veterans." He decided to build the needed homes for a low price of \$4,000. At the time of the article, Benson had built three of the seven homes. "The homes are 28 X 28, with kitchen, bedroom, and living room. Included is a modern bathroom with built-in tub and other attractive appointments. Hardwood floors are in the living room and bedroom. The kitchen has attractive inlaid linoleum, sink-cabinet units and wiring for electric stoves."



The article was found in an old scrapbook belonging to the late Bess McQueen, a Tremont resident. With his vision of low-cost housing for veterans, J.L. Benson joined the ranks of others in Tremont who, through the years, have made sure our veterans were taken care of or recognized for their service to our country.
