

# EMT-Basic Class

## Course Description:

Emergency Medical Technicians-Basic (EMT-B) respond to emergency calls to provide efficient and immediate care to the sick and injured. This course is geared toward getting students comfortable with performing in an emergency situation.

Classes are lecture/instruction with hands-on teaching. Total class time is 172 hours. Clinical time includes an additional 16 hours in the Emergency Department and ambulance internship. Once the student successfully completes this course, he/she will be able to test for a State of Illinois license.

## Skills learned:

- Patient assessment
- Airway, ventilating patients
- Administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), using automated external defibrillators
- Providing emergency medical care of simple and multiple system trauma
- Controlling hemorrhage, bandaging wounds, stabilizing injured extremities
- Assisting in childbirth
- Managing general medical complaints, altered mental status, seizures, environmental emergencies, behavioral emergencies and psychological crises.
- Administering life-saving medications including oxygen, sublingual nitroglycerin, epinephrine, oral glucose, glucagon, aerosol inhalers, and Narcan

Class held at the **Tremont Fire Station**, 300 S. Sampson ST. Class size is limited to 15 students. Enrollment will be determined by the order in which class fees are received.

Students must be 18 years old and have a high school diploma or GED or graduating from high school in May 2017.
