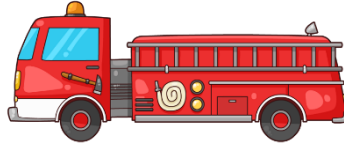
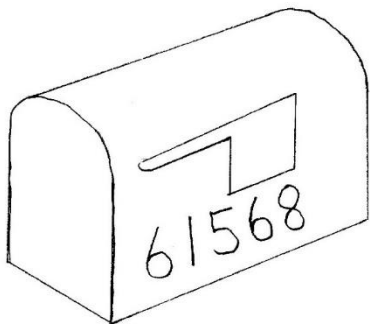


# Help Us Help You!



***If we can't find you quickly, then we can't help you quickly***

- Post address numbers near the main entrance of your home but not further than 80 feet from the road.
- Address numbers on homes/buildings should have a minimum height of 4 inches.
- If your home is more than 80 feet from the road, post your address numbers on a sign, post, or mailbox near the entrance to your property.
- Numbers on signs and posts should be between 30 inches and 60 inches above ground level.
- Address numbers on mailboxes or posts should have a minimum height of 3 inches and be visible from both directions when driving on a roadway.
- Properties with common shared lanes/driveways should have one posting to show the range of addresses along the shared entrance and also at the entrances of the individual properties.



## **Good Mailbox Example**

- Numbers contrast to color of box
- Numbers at least 3 inches tall
- Numbers visible when flag is down
- No missing numbers
