Trustee Getz reported meeting with Eric Hansen in hopes of creating a check list of guidelines to be followed before future sidewalk reimbursements would be made. Also discussed were city alleyways and which of those merited maintenance.

Eric Hansen was in attendance to report on the Sampson Street Project in coordination with Winning Communities. They discussed working in phases, but Hansen warned that at this time the Village had no designated funds for the project. Winning Communities intends to promote the project at the Turkey Festival in an effort to raise needed monies. Hansen said that the Walnut St. intersection would cost around \$500,000.

Trustee Harding moved to approve Resolution 18-101 calling for the temporary closure of Route 9 for the Turkey Festival parade, and Getz seconded.

Trustee Zuercher moved to approve the standard agreement for professional services between engineering firm CMT and the Village of Tremont for the period of May 1, 2018 to April 31, 2019. Getz seconded.
