They were asked to drop off a map showing these locations.

Todd Abercrombie, from *Evergreen Home Energy Consultants*, presented his energy audit to the Board indicating that the areas of main concern were the two furnaces, insulation and ductwork.

Abercrombie explained that one furnace could replace the two existing furnaces, the ceiling insulation had been improperly done, and that much of the ductwork was disconnected. New lighting and ceilings were also in need of replacement and that Ameren Incentives would help the cost.

In final business, Angela Conn requested board approval for the Turkey Festival Parade route which would be the same as past parades. Police Chief Mike Dodwell gave his approval, and the Board will act officially at the March 2 meeting.

Angela was also concerned about standing water in the street by her residence, and Trustee Scranton promised to look into a solution.
