Have you been wondering what that new building on Main Street is? It's the future home of the Share Closet and the Tremont Food Pantry! The Tremont Food Pantry is currently operating out of the Methodist Church basement but will move to the new building after it is completed. If you're wondering more about the Share Closet, read on!

What is the Share Closet? We are a local ministry operating as a resale shop committed to providing quality items for our community. We have high-quality, low-cost, gently-used clothing, accessories, and shoes for the entire family, as well as toys, electronics, baby items, home décor, books, kitchen items, furniture, baby supplies, and many other household items. We are currently located upstairs at Northfield Christian Fellowship (411 W. North Street). If you haven't visited us yet, we invite to you come and check us out!

When is the Share Closet open? The current hours are Tuesdays Noon-2pm,

Wednesday evenings 5:30-7pm, Thursdays 10-Noon, and Fridays 11-3. (When we get into the new building, we will have more consistent hours!)

When will the Share Closet (and Food Pantry) move into the new building? We expect that the building will be completed this fall. After the building is finished, we will close the Share Closet for a few weeks to move all of our inventory over to the new location. We will publish these dates as soon as we can, hopefully by mid-September.

The goal for the Captain's Corner is to communicate clearly and effectively with the readers to keep them informed. The Captain's Corner will be published the first week of every month in the Winning Communities newsletter, the link to the newsletter will be shared on our Tremont Police Department Facebook page.

Who am I? Again, my Name Is Nate Troyer. I was born and raised in Hopedale and graduated from Olympia High School. Growing up, my parents owned a restaurant in Hopedale called "The Cove", I feel I was fortunate to be raised by parents who owned a small business because it was truly a family business, so I was taught work ethic and how to treat people with respect at a young age. I moved to Tremont after I was hired as a full-time police officer in May of 2000 and now consider Tremont my home town.

Who is the Tremont Police Department? We are 13 state certified police officers with over 200 years of combined experience. Broken down even farther, we have 3 full-time police officers that consist of the chief (Michael Dodwell), myself and Officer Justin McKinley, and 10 part-time officers. You may be thinking right now, Captain Troyer do we really need that many? The answer is yes, and I would like to have a couple more. All of our part-time officers have other full-time jobs; 7 of the 10 work full-time in law enforcement for another agency, one is full-time dispatcher, one is a full-time security supervisor for a local hospital, the other is full time in sales and mainly helps with Turkey Festival. Those officers patrol the incorporated limits of the village and respond to approximately 1200 calls for service every year.

In closing I would like to say we can have lots of officers with lots of years of experience but it truly takes a community keep our people safe. If you see crime, suspicious activity, something that doesn't look right or just have a gut feeling about something, no matter how petty or small you think it is, give us a call. You're not a bother or a burden. We truly want to help. Help us help you by calling 911 in case of an emergency or (309) 925-5102 for non-emergency calls.
