Did you know...?

History Was Made Here

Be sure to attend the Tremont Historical Society's September 20th program to learn more!

Some of the most famous names in U.S. history had occasion to visit Tremont regularly. The word,

"Tremont," would have been spoken by them with frequency. Many Tremont residents knew of them, and some were close friends.

In 1836, just a year after Tremont was founded, the town won the coveted Tazewell County Seat. An impressive Grecian courthouse was built on the pretty Courthouse Square at South James and Washington Street. It soon became a center of business for the Illinois 8th Judicial Circuit. Abraham Lincoln was a young lawyer and David Davis was the circuit court judge. Along with another lawyer, they traveled by horseback and carriage from town to town on the circuit to hear cases, coming to Tremont and its courthouse often. Lincoln and Davis became good friends.

The two were guests at several Tremont homes, including the Jones-Menard home, sometimes called, "The Red Brick."


Little could they know that one day, Lincoln would become President of the United States during arguably its most trying times, and that David Davis would become a U.S. Supreme Court Justice and then the U.S. Senate president pro tempore.

History was made right here...the story just gets more interesting!
